Pray like Jesus: God Forgives—Do You?

Matt 6:9-13

⁹ "This, then, is how you should pray: "'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, ¹⁰ your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. ¹¹ Give us today our daily bread. ¹² Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. ¹³ And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.'

1. FORGIVE BECAUSE GOD FORGIVES US

Romans 3:23-25

23... <u>all have sinned</u> and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and <u>are justified freely by his grace</u> through the <u>redemption that came by Christ Jesus</u>. 25 God presented him as a <u>sacrifice of atonement</u>, through <u>faith in his blood</u>.

Eph 4:31-32

31 Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. ³² Be kind and compassionate to one another, <u>forgiving each other</u>, <u>just as in Christ God forgave you</u>.

Luke 23:34

Jesus said, "Father, <u>forgive them</u>, for <u>they do not know what</u> they are doing."

Acts 7:59-60

⁵⁹ While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." ⁶⁰ Then he fell on his knees and cried out, "Lord, <u>do not hold this sin against them</u>." When he had said this, he fell asleep.

2. FORGIVE BECAUSE IT IS REQUIRED OF US

<u>Matthew 6:14-15</u> (Jesus said immediately after Lord's Prayer)

14 For <u>if you forgive</u> men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But <u>if you do not forgive</u> men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Mark 11:25

And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, <u>forgive him</u>, so that your Father in heaven <u>may</u> <u>forgive you</u> your sins."

3. FORGIVE BECAUSE IT FREES US

"To forgive is to set a prisoner free and discover that the prisoner was you." Lewis B. Smedes

<u>Unresolved Anger</u> becomes <u>Unforgiveness</u>, and <u>Unforgiveness</u> becomes <u>Bitterness</u>, and <u>Bitterness</u> takes <u>Root</u> in our <u>Heart</u>, and holds us in <u>Bondage</u> and will <u>Consume</u> us.

Jesus <u>taught us to Forgive</u> because He knew the <u>power of Unforgiveness</u> to <u>Destroy us</u>.

And He knows the <u>power of Forgiveness</u> to <u>Free us</u>.

Ezekiel 36:26

I will give you a <u>new heart</u> and put a <u>new spirit</u> in you; I will <u>remove from you your heart of stone</u> and <u>give you a heart of</u> flesh.
