Pray like Jesus: You have an Enemy!

Matt 3:16-Matt 4:11

16 As soon as Iesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting on him. ¹⁷ And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased." Matt 4:1 Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. ² After fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. ³ The tempter came to him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread." ⁴ Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." ⁵ Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. ⁶ "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: "He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone." ⁷ Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'" ⁸ Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. ⁹ "All this I will give you," he said, "if you will bow down and worship me." 10 Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'" 11 Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him.

1. THE BATTLE IS <u>REAL</u>, SATAN IS THE <u>ENEMY</u> AND HE WANTS TO <u>DESTROY</u> YOU.

Matt 6:13 "And <u>lead us not into temptation</u>, but <u>deliver us from the evil</u> one."

Eph 6:12

For <u>our struggle</u> is <u>not against flesh and blood</u>, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

1 Peter 5:8-9

8 Be self-controlled and alert. <u>Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour</u>. 9 Resist him, standing firm in the faith...

2. SATAN TEMPTS US <u>WHEN</u> AND <u>WHERE</u> WE ARE MOST VULNERABLE—AND NO ONE IS EXEMPT.

Matthew 4:1

Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert <u>to be tempted by the devil</u>.

Jesus was tempted with...

- > PHYSICAL DESIRES: Jesus was tired and hungry.
- > PRIDE & AMBITION: Jesus had just been <u>baptized</u> and <u>anointed</u> as the Son of God. Satan desired to <u>sabotage</u> His <u>mission</u>.
- ➤ <u>IDOLATRY</u>: "All this I will give you," he said, "<u>if you will bow down and worship me</u>." (Matt 4:9)

□ Remember, TEMPTATION IS NOT SIN

Hebrews 4:15

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have <u>one who has been tempted in every way</u>, just as we are-<u>yet was without sin</u>.

1 Corinthians 10:13

... God is faithful; <u>he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear</u>. But when you are tempted, <u>he will also provide a way out</u> so that you can stand up under it.

3. GOD HAS NOT LEFT US DEFENSELESS.
