Galatians 3:23-4:7

23 Before this faith came, we were held prisoners by the law, locked up until faith should be revealed. 24 So the law was put in charge to lead us to Christ that we might be justified by faith. 25 Now that faith has come, we are no longer under the supervision of the law. 26 You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, 27 for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. 4:1 What I am saying is that as long as the heir is a child, he is no different from a slave, although he owns the whole estate. 2 He is subject to guardians and trustees until the time set by his father. 3 So also, when we were children, we were in slavery under the basic principles of the world. 4 But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, 5 to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. 6 Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father." 7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.

1. JESUS WAS <u>BORN</u> UNDER THE LAW

4:4 But when the time had fully come, <u>God sent his Son</u>, born of a woman, <u>born under law</u>,

<u>Gal 3:13</u> <u>Christ redeemed us from the curse</u> of the law <u>by</u> <u>becoming a curse for us</u>, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."

- 2. TO <u>REDEEM</u> THOSE UNDER THE LAW
 - 4:5 to redeem those under law...

<u>Redeem</u>: "to set free by paying a price"

3. SO THAT WE MIGHT BECOME <u>SONS</u> (<u>HEIRS</u>) OF GOD

4:5 to redeem those under law, that we might receive the \underline{full} rights of sons.

4:7 So you are no longer a slave, but <u>a son;</u> and since you are a son, God has made you also <u>an heir</u>.

3:29 If you belong to Christ, then you are <u>Abraham's seed</u>, and <u>heirs</u> according to the promise.

3:27 for <u>all of you</u> who were <u>baptized into Christ</u> have <u>clothed</u> <u>yourselves with Christ</u>.

CONCLUSION:

4:4 But <u>when the time had fully come</u>, <u>God sent his Son</u>, born of a woman, <u>born under law</u>, 5 <u>to redeem those under law</u>, that <u>we might</u> <u>receive the full rights of sons</u>.

<u>Rom 5:6, 8</u>

6 You see, <u>at just the right time</u>, when we were <u>still powerless</u>, Christ died for <u>the ungodly</u>. 8 But <u>God demonstrates his own love</u> <u>for us</u> in this: <u>While we were still sinners</u>, Christ <u>died for us</u>.
