Stewards: Living a God-Pleasing Life

Acts 2:41-47

41 Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. 42 They **devoted themselves** to the **apostles' teaching** and to the **fellowship**, to the **breaking of bread** and to **prayer**. 43 Everyone was filled with awe, and **many wonders and miraculous signs were done** by the apostles. 44 **All the believers were together** and **had everything in common**. 45 Selling their possessions and goods, **they gave** to anyone as he had need. 46 Every day they continued to **meet together** in the temple courts. They **broke bread** in their homes and **ate together** with **glad and sincere hearts**, 47 **praising God** and **enjoying the favor of all the people**. And the Lord **added to their number daily** those who were being saved.

We give because...

1. GOD GAVE

<u>John 3:16</u>

"For God so <u>loved</u> the world that he <u>gave</u> his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

We <u>Love</u> because God <u>Loved</u>! We <u>Give</u> because God <u>Gave</u>! God GAVE <u>His only Son</u>. You and I are made <u>in His image</u>. And He is a <u>GIVER</u>. He gave Everything. How can we be Christ-like <u>when we don't give</u>?

Dave Ramsey...

Giving makes us more Christ-like! You can't claim that you are a spiritually mature Christian, when you are not giving. Because a spiritually mature Christian is by definition Christ-like, who by definition is a Giver. When we learn how to be a giver, we are becoming what God has designed us to be.

We give because...

2. IT'S NOT OUR <u>STUFF</u>, IT'S <u>GOD'S</u>

One of the first words we learn as children is MINE!

We are not <u>Owners</u>, we are <u>Stewards</u>.

<u>1 Chron 29:14</u> (King David responds to God's blessings) "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should <u>be</u> <u>able to give</u> as generously as this? <u>Everything comes from</u> <u>you, and we have given you only what comes from your</u> <u>hand</u>."

We give because...

3. GOD WANTS OUR WHOLE <u>HEART</u>

Tithing isn't <u>fundamentally</u> about <u>money</u>. It's about the <u>condition of our heart</u> before God.

Matt 6:21

Where <u>your treasure</u> is, there <u>your heart</u> will be also.

It's <u>not your wallet</u> that God wants, it's <u>your heart</u>. But until He gets <u>your wallet</u>, He'll never fully have <u>your</u> <u>heart</u>.

<u>Luke 16:13</u>

"<u>No servant can serve two masters</u>. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. <u>You cannot serve both God and Money</u>."

Jesus is saying that there's always a <u>clear winner</u> in the Godversus-money battle.

God's call for stewardship <u>smokes out the true winner</u> of the God-versus-money battle in our life.
