Run the Race: Offer them Christ

Matt 28:16-20

Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

To Offer Christ, we must...

1. <u>UNDERSTAND</u> WHO <u>CHRIST</u> IS

Matt 16:15-19 (Jesus Talking with Peter)
15 "But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?" 16
Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the
living God." 17 Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of
Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by man, but by my
Father in heaven. 18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on
this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not
overcome it.

To Offer Christ, we must...

2. BE TRANSMORMED BY HIS LOVE

SAUL / PAUL (on Road to Damascus) - ACTS 9

JOHN WESLEY - from his Journal - May 24th 1738
"In the evening I went very unwillingly to a society in Aldersgate
Street, where one was reading Luther's preface to the Epistle to the
Romans. About a quarter before nine, while he was describing the
change which God works in the heart through faith in Christ, I felt my
heart strangely warmed. I felt I did trust in Christ, Christ alone, for
salvation; and an assurance was given me that He had taken away my
sins, even mine, and saved me from the law of sin and death."

3. SHARE OUR FAITH STORY

Mark 5:18-20 (Demons cast into pigs)
18 As Jesus was getting into the boat, the man who had been demon-possessed begged to go with him. 19 Jesus did not let him, but said, "Go home to your family and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you." 20 So the man went away and began to tell in the Decapolis how much Jesus had done for him. And all the people were amazed.

"I began to pray with all my might for those who had in a more special manner despitefully used me and persecuted me. <u>I then testified openly to all</u> there what I now first felt in my heart."
