Sheepish (Life Lessons from Psalm 23): ABUNDANCE Wylie United Methodist Church Pastor Jeff Hatcher – February 19, 2012

<u>Psalm 23:1-6</u>

I The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. 3 He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever. (NKJV)

What can we learn from verse 5?

I. WE HAVE AN <u>ENEMY</u>

v.5 "You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies..."

<u>Eph 6:12</u>

For <u>our struggle is not against flesh and blood</u>, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

<u>1 Peter 5:8</u>

Be self-controlled and alert. <u>Your enemy the devil prowls around</u> <u>like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour</u>.

<u> John 10:10</u>

The thief comes only <u>to steal and kill and destroy</u>; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

Luke 22:31-32

31 "Simon, Simon, <u>Satan has asked to sift you as wheat</u>. 32 But I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail." We have an enemy but...

2. HE HAS BEEN DEFEATED

v.5 "You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies..."

<u>Mesa</u>: The shepherd prepares the mesa (<u>Table</u>)

<u>Jesus has prepared our table</u> (Lord's Table) because He has gone before us.

The enemy is defeated and...

3. WE HAVE RECEIVED THE HOLY SPIRIT

v.5 "... You anoint my head with oil..."

Oil symbolizes: - The Holy Spirit

<u>John 16:7</u>

But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, <u>the Counselor</u> will not come to you; but if I go, <u>I will send him to you</u>.

Since we have the Holy Spirit...

4. WE CAN LIVE IN <u>ABUNDANCE</u>

v.5 "... My cup runs over."

<u>Isa 61:3</u>

[The Lord has anointed me] to bestow on them a <u>crown of</u> <u>beauty instead of ashes</u>, the <u>oil of gladness instead of</u> <u>mourning</u>, and a <u>garment of praise instead of a spirit of</u> <u>despair</u>.
