Psalm 23:1-6

I The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. 3 He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever. (NKJV)

1. WE ARE BLESSED TO BE A BLESSING

"Surely"

Lam 3:22-23

22 Because of the Lord's great <u>love</u> (<u>mercies</u>-KJV) we are not consumed, for his <u>compassions</u> never fail. 23 They are <u>new every morning</u>; great is your faithfulness.

"follow me"

<u>John 10:11</u>

11 "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd <u>lays down his life</u> for the sheep.

1 John 3:16

16 This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.

2. WE ARE ALWAYS IN HIS <u>PRESENCE</u> AND UNDER HIS CARE

"... all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever."

Because the Lord is our Shepherd...

3. WE HAVE <u>HOPE</u> NO MATTER THE <u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u>

WHO JESUS IS:

- He is our <u>Good Shepherd</u> (v. 1)

WHAT JESUS DOES FOR US:

- He provides for all our needs (v. 1-2)
- He <u>restores</u> our <u>soul</u> (v. 3)
- He <u>empowers</u> us to <u>holy living</u> for <u>His glory</u> (v. 3)
- He provides strength to face whatever comes (v. 4)
- He <u>provides</u> <u>comfort</u> (v. 4)
- He provides power and protection (v. 5)

WHAT ARE THE RESULTS:

- We have <u>hope</u> (v. 6)

In Christ's presence we are never without hope.

<u>Isa 40:11</u>

[The Sovereign Lord] <u>tends his flock</u> like a shepherd: He <u>gathers the</u> <u>lambs in his arms</u> and <u>carries them close to his heart</u>; he <u>gently leads</u> those that have young.
