Sheepish (Life Lessons from Psalm 23): PEACE Wylie United Methodist Church Pastor Jeff Hatcher – January 29, 2012

#### <u>Psalm 23:1-6</u>

I The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 <u>He makes me to lie down</u> <u>in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters</u>. 3 He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake. 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever. (NKJV)

Sheep aren't natural born sleepers.

In order for sheep to lie down to rest, <u>four things</u> have to be in place.

### The sheep must be:

- Free from <u>fear of attack</u> (their enemies)
- Free from <u>friction and tension</u> within the flock (the 1<sup>st</sup> will be last, the last will be 1<sup>st</sup>)
- Free from <u>aggravations</u> (gnats and flies, trials)
- Free from <u>hunger</u> (full bellies, physical needs met)

### Keller makes this observation:

"In the course of time I came to realize that <u>nothing so quieted and</u> <u>reassured the sheep as to see me in the field.</u>"

Your Good Shepherd (Jesus) wants you to have peace. He wants you to lie down in <u>rich</u>, <u>green pastures</u>. He wants you to be filled by the pure "<u>living water</u>" of life. <u>HE IS THE LIVING WATER</u>. How do you get there?

### I. <u>SURRENDER</u> TO THE <u>LEADERSHIP</u> OF THE "GOOD SHEPHERD"

"He makes me to lie down..." "He leads me beside..."

# 2. <u>Celebrate</u> The <u>peace</u> that the shepherd provides

#### <u>Luke 2:8</u>

And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, <u>keeping watch over their flocks at night</u>.

# 3. <u>IDENTIFY</u> YOUR GREEN <u>PASTURES</u> AND STILL <u>WATERS</u>

- Identify and proactively <u>pursue</u> ways that Christ <u>replenishes</u> you.
- <u>Seek out</u> ways that God "<u>fills your cup</u>".
- Avoid "joy suckers" and false watering holes.
