1. GOD LOVED

From Greek word "Agape":

- □ to love without condition
- □ to love <u>without regard</u> for love <u>returned</u>
- □ to love <u>based on high regard</u> for an individuals <u>inherent</u> <u>value</u>

2. GOD GAVE

"... that he gave his one and only Son..."

Agape:

☐ an active love ("Love is a Verb" - Steven Covey)

Eph 5:25 "love as Christ loved the church"

Romans 5:8

God <u>demonstrates his own love</u> for us in this: <u>While we were still sinners</u>, <u>Christ died for us</u>.

3. WE BELIEVE

"... that whoever believes in him shall not perish "

Rom 10:9
