What If I Loved Sacrificially?

1 Cor 13:1-8a

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. 2 If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. 3 If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing. 4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. 5 It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. 6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. 7 It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. 8 Love never fails...

1. GOD IS THE <u>SOURCE</u> OF SACRIFICIAL LOVE.

I John 4:7-12

7 Dear friends, let us love one another, for <u>love comes from God</u>. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. 8 Whoever does not love does not know God, because <u>God is love</u>. 9 This is how <u>God showed his love</u> among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world <u>that we might live through him</u>. 10 <u>This is love</u>: not that we loved God, but that he <u>loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins</u>. 11 Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

2. SACRIFICIAL LOVE IS <u>ACTIVE</u> AND INTENTIONAL.

4 Love is <u>patient</u>, love is <u>kind</u>. It does <u>not envy</u>, it does <u>not</u> <u>boast</u>, it is <u>not proud</u>. 5 It is <u>not rude</u>, it is <u>not self-seeking</u>, it is <u>not easily angered</u>, it keeps <u>no record of wrongs</u>. 6 Love does <u>not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth</u>. 7 It <u>always protects</u>, always <u>trusts</u>, always <u>hopes</u>, always <u>perseveres</u>. 8 Love <u>never fails</u>...

John 3:16

16 "For <u>God so loved</u> the world that <u>he gave</u> his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 15:12-13

12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. 13 <u>Greater love has no one than this</u>, that <u>he lay down his life</u> for his friends.

Rom 5:6-8

6 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. 7 Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, though for a good man someone might possibly dare to die. 8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

3. SACRIFICIAL LOVE IS A CHOICE.

Jesus' love for you, was His motivation to go to the cross.

Heb 12:2

Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross...

And <u>if love is a choice</u>, then <u>we have the capability to choose to love</u> even when we don't "<u>feel</u>" in love anymore.

4. THE HOLY SPIRIT <u>EMPOWERS</u> US TO LOVE SACRIFICIALLY.

Rom 5:5

And hope does not disappoint us, because <u>God has poured out</u> <u>his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit</u>, whom he has given us.

Gal 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control...
