- Prayers

Acts 2:42

42 They devoted themselves ... to prayer.

2. PEOPLE OF COVENANT GROW

- Presence

Acts 2:42, 44 & 46

42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship ... 44 All the believers were together and had everything in common. 46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts...

3. PEOPLE OF COVENANT GIVE

- Gifts

Acts 2:45

45 Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need.

Acts 4:32, 34-35

32 All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they shared everything they had. 34 There were no needy persons among them. For from time to time those who owned lands or houses sold them, brought the money from the sales 35 and put it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to anyone as he had need.

Acts 2:43

- Witness

Acts 2:41, 47
