Psalms 8:1-9

I O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens. 2 From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise because of your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger. 3 When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, 4 what is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him? 5 You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor. 6 You made him ruler over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet: 7 all flocks and herds, and the beasts of the field, 8 the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas. 9 O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

1. GOD IS REAL

Psa 8:1 "O Lord, our Lord..." (David addresses God personally)

5 proofs that God is real:

A. <u>FIRST CAUSE</u>: It is a scientific fact that every action has a cause (Cause and Effect). When we extend this idea into the past we realize that our universe and everything in it must have had a "first cause" -- GOD!

Psa 102:25-26

25 In the beginning <u>you laid the foundations of the earth</u>, and <u>the heavens are the work of your hands</u>. 26 They will perish, but <u>you remain</u>;

B. <u>INTELLIGENT DESIGN</u>: Watches, houses, ships, computers, etc., all exhibit intelligent design. The universe exhibits design, therefore, the universe must have been planned and produced by an intelligent designer. An intelligent creator -- GOD!

Rom. 1:20 For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities-his eternal power and divine nature-have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.

C. <u>REASONING & MORALITY</u>: Only human beings have the ability to <u>think abstractly</u> and make choices based on <u>morality</u> rather than instinct.

Rom 2:15

... the requirements of the law are written on their hearts...

D. <u>RISK -vs- REWARD</u>: If a person chooses to believe in God and He does not exist, then nothing is lost and a moral life has been lived. However, if a person chooses not to believe in God and He does exist, then everything is lost. Is it worth the risk?

Prov 14:12

There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death.

Psalms 53:1 The fool says in his heart, "There is no God."

E. <u>A CHANGED LIFE</u>: God has to exist because He changed my life.

2. GOD IS OMNIPOTENT (unlimited power)

Psa 8:1

I O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.

Ps 19:1

The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.

3. GOD IS THE MASTER CRAFTSMAN

Psa 8:5

You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and <u>crowned</u> <u>him</u> with glory and honor.

Eph 2:10 "You are God's workmanship (masterpiece)."

4. GOD IS LOVE

Psa 8:4

What is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him?

He has revealed His LOVE through JESUS CHRIST!
