<u>Psalms 13</u>

I How long, O Lord? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me? 2 How long must I wrestle with my thoughts and every day have sorrow in my heart? How long will my enemy triumph over me? 3 Look on me and answer, O Lord my God. Give light to my eyes, or I will sleep in death; 4 my enemy will say, "I have overcome him," and my foes will rejoice when I fall. 5 But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart rejoices in your salvation. 6 I will sing to the Lord, for he has been good to me.

3 things to do when God seems far away:

The 1st thing to do is...

I. ASSUME GOD'S <u>PRESENCE</u>, AND <u>DO</u> WHAT YOU KNOW TO <u>DO</u>.

<u>Psalms 13</u>

The 2^{nd} thing to do when God seems far away is...

2. <u>CLING</u> TO WHAT YOU KNOW IS <u>TRUE</u>.

- So, what is true about God?
- He <u>Loves</u> You! <u>Psalms 13</u> 5 But I trust in your <u>unfailing love</u>;

- He has <u>Saved</u> You! <u>Psalms 13</u> 5 ... my heart rejoices in <u>your salvation</u>.
- He has <u>Blessed</u> You! <u>Psalms 13</u> 6 ... he has been <u>good to me</u>.
- The 3^{rd} thing to do when God seems far away is...

3. KEEP <u>PRAISING</u> HIM.

<u>Psalms 13</u>

1 How long...? How long...? 2 How long...? How long...? BUT...

6 <u>I will sing to the Lord</u>, for he has been good to me.

Hebrews 13:15

Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise — the fruit of lips that confess his name.

Philippians 4:4

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: <u>Rejoice</u>!

<u>Psalms 100:4</u>

Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.

James 1:2-4

2 Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, 3 because you know that <u>the testing of your</u> <u>faith develops perseverance</u>. 4 Perseverance must finish its work <u>so that you may be mature and complete</u>, not lacking anything.
