4 FACTS ABOUT HOPE:

THERE'S A DIFFERENCE BETWEEN WHIMSICAL, FANCIFUL HOPE AND CHRISTIAN HOPE

Heb 11:1

Now <u>faith</u> is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.

2. HOPE <u>DEMONSTRATES</u> TO THE WORLD THAT WE <u>BELONG</u> TO CHRIST

1 Thess 4:13

13 ... we do not want you to grieve like the rest of men, who have no hope.

3. NON-BELIEVERS <u>CANNOT HAVE</u> CHRISTIAN HOPE

Eph 2:12

12 remember that at that time <u>you were separate from Christ</u>, ... <u>without hope</u> and without God in the world.

4. THE <u>OPPOSITE</u> OF HOPE IS <u>DESPAIR</u> (OR <u>DISCOURAGEMENT</u>)

3 FACTS ABOUT DISCOURAGEMENT:

CHRISTIAN HOPE COMES FROM GOD...
<u>DISCOURAGEMENT</u> COMES FROM <u>SATAN</u>

- 2. DISCOURAGEMENT IS ONE OF SATANS MAIN WEAPONS AGAINST US
- 3. DISCOURAGEMENT IS NOT A <u>CONDITION</u>, IT'S A CHOICE!

3 KEYS TO OVERCOMING DISCOURAGEMENT:

1. SET YOUR HEART AND MIND ON GOD

Col 3:1-3

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, <u>set your hearts</u> <u>on things above</u>, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. 2 <u>Set your minds on things above</u>, not on earthly things.

Ps 16:8

I have <u>set the Lord always before me</u>. Because <u>he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken</u>.

2. EXPECT TRIALS IN THIS LIFE

1 Peter 1:3-8

3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4-5 ... 6 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. 7 These have come so that your faith — of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire — may be proved genuine and may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed.

3. TAKE OUR EYES OFF <u>OURSELVES</u> AND PLACE THEM ON CHRIST

Hebrews 12:2-3

Let us <u>fix our eyes on Jesus</u>, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross... <u>so</u> that you will not grow weary and lose heart.
