Matthew 22:34-40 (Great Commandment)

34 Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. 35 One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: 36 "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" 37 Jesus replied: "<u>Love the Lord your God</u> with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: <u>'Love your</u> <u>neighbor as yourself.</u>' 40 <u>All the Law and the Prophets hang on</u> <u>these two commandments</u>."

HOW IS CHRIST CALLING HIS CHURCH TO LOVE PEOPLE?

To love people, we must...

1. LOVE GOD <u>FIRST</u> AND KNOW THAT HE LOVES <u>SINNERS</u>!

<u>1 John 4:19</u> We love because <u>he first loved us</u>.

<u>1 John 3:16</u>

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.

Romans 5:8

<u>God demonstrates his own love for us</u> in this: <u>While we were</u> <u>still sinners</u>, <u>Christ died for us</u>.

To love people, we must...

2. KNOW GOD'S <u>WORD</u>!

<u>2 Timothy 3:16</u> All Scripture is <u>God-breathed</u>...

<u>2 Peter 1:16</u>

<u>We did not follow cleverly invented stories</u> when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but <u>we</u> were eyewitnesses of his majesty.

John 17:17

[Jesus said] Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.

Matt 19:3-6 (the two shall become one flesh)

Rom 1:24-27

24 God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another. 25 <u>They exchanged the truth of God for a lie</u>, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creatorwho is forever praised. Amen. 26 Because of this, God gave them over to shameful lusts. Even their <u>women exchanged</u> <u>natural relations for unnatural ones</u>. 27 In the same way the <u>men</u> <u>also abandoned natural relations with women and were</u> <u>inflamed with lust for one another</u>. <u>Men committed indecent</u> <u>acts with other men</u>, and received in themselves the due penalty for their perversion.

<u>1 Cor 6:9</u>

Do you not know that the wicked will <u>not inherit the kingdom</u> <u>of God</u>? Do not be deceived: Neither the <u>sexually immoral</u> nor <u>idolaters</u> nor <u>adulterers</u> nor <u>male prostitutes</u> nor <u>homosexual</u> <u>offenders</u> ...

To love people, we must...

3. INTRODUCE THEM TO THE GREAT <u>HEALER!</u> John 10:10

<u>The thief</u> comes only to <u>steal</u> and <u>kill</u> and <u>destroy</u>; <u>I have come</u> that they <u>may have life</u>, and have it <u>to the full</u> (more abundantly).

People are broken because of sin. Every command God gives is to lead us from brokenness to "<u>Abundant Life</u>".
