"God's Blueprint for our Church: Offer Christ" Wylie United Methodist Church Pastor Jeff Hatcher – September 21, 2014

2 Corinthians 5:14-21

14 For <u>Christ's love compels us</u>, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died. 15 And he died for all, that <u>those</u> <u>who live</u> should <u>no longer live for themselves but for him</u> who died for them and was raised again. 16 So from now on <u>we regard no one</u> <u>from a worldly point of view</u>. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. 17 Therefore, <u>if anyone is in Christ</u>, <u>he</u> <u>is a new creation</u>; <u>the old has gone</u>, <u>the new has come</u>! 18 All this is from God, who <u>reconciled us to himself through Christ</u> and <u>gave us</u> <u>the ministry of reconciliation</u>: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And <u>he has committed to us the message of reconciliation</u>. 20 <u>We</u> <u>are therefore Christ's ambassadors</u>, as though <u>God were making his</u> <u>appeal through us</u>. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. 21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that <u>in</u> <u>him we might become the righteousness of God</u>.

To Offer Christ we must...

1. BE MADE <u>NEW</u> THROUGH <u>FAITH</u> IN JESUS CHRIST!

(LOVE GOD)

<u>2 Cor 5:</u>

17 Therefore, <u>if anyone is in Christ</u>, <u>he is a new creation</u>; <u>the old</u> <u>has gone</u>, <u>the new has come</u>! 18 All this is from God, who <u>reconciled us to himself through Christ</u> and <u>gave us the ministry</u> <u>of reconciliation</u>:

<u>RECONCILE</u>: Make <u>peace</u>, restore <u>harmony</u> or right <u>relationship</u>

To Offer Christ we must...

2. SEE PEOPLE THROUGH THE EYES OF <u>CHRIST</u>! (LOVE PEOPLE)

<u>2 Cor 5:</u>

To Offer Christ we must...

3. LET THE LOVE OF CHRIST <u>COMPEL</u> US TO <u>ACTION!</u> (OFFER CHRIST) <u>2 Cor 5:</u> 14 For <u>Christ's love compels us...</u>
