1 Corinthians 13

I If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. 2 If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. 3 If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing. 4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. 5 It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. 6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. 7 It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. 8 Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. 9 For we know in part and we prophesy in part, 10 but when perfection comes, the imperfect disappears. 11 When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put childish ways behind me. 12 Now we see but a poor reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known. 13 And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

Love is not a feeling. It is intentional and sacrificial.

God <u>demonstrates his own love</u> for us in this: <u>While we were still sinners</u>, <u>Christ died for us</u>. (Romans 5:8)

A Life of Love is...

1. MODELED BY CHRIST

- Christ was a <u>servant</u> He <u>humbled Himself</u> for our sake
- He took the punishment that we deserved upon Himself
- He forgives us
 He loves us as we are

- ➤ A LIFE WITHOUT LOVE IS <u>JUST NOISE</u>

- A LIFE WITHOUT LOVE HAS <u>NO SIGNIFICANCE</u>

 <u>1 Cor 13:2</u> If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, <u>I am nothing</u>.
- A LIFE WITHOUT LOVE HAS <u>NO PURPOSE</u>

 <u>1 Cor 13:3</u> If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing.

2. DISTINCT QUALITIES

- LOVE IS:
 - I Cor 13:4 is patient, is kind
 - 6 rejoices with the truth.
 - 7 <u>always protects</u>, <u>always trusts</u>, <u>always hopes</u>, <u>always perseveres</u>.
 - 8 never fails.

- LOVE IS NOT:

- I Cor 13:4 does not envy, does not boast, not proud.
- 5 <u>not rude</u>, <u>not self-seeking</u>, <u>not easily angered</u>, <u>keeps no record of wrongs</u>.
- 6 does not delight in evil
