Matt 16:13-18

13 When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?" 14 They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets." 15 "But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?" 16 Simon Peter answered, "<u>You are the Christ, the Son of the living God</u>." 17 Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by man, but by my Father in heaven. 18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and <u>on this rock I will build my church</u>, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.

As Christians, WE BELIEVE that we are...

- I. <u>HOLY</u>
 - GOD, <u>THE FATHER</u> IS HOLY.

<u>Isa 6:3</u>

And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."

➢ GOD, <u>THE SON</u> IS HOLY.

<u>John 6:68-69</u>

68 Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. 69 We believe and know that <u>you are the Holy One of God</u>."

➢ GOD, <u>THE HOLY SPIRIT</u> IS HOLY.

HIS FOLLOWERS ARE CALLED TO BE HOLY. <u>I Peter 1:15</u>

But just as <u>he who called you is holy</u>, so <u>be holy in all you</u> <u>do</u>; 16 for it is written: "<u>Be holy</u>, <u>because I am holy</u>." As Christians, WE BELIEVE that we are...

2. <u>CATHOLIC</u> (universal)

<u>John 17:20-21</u>

20 "My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, 21 that <u>all of them may</u> <u>be one</u>, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us <u>so that the world may believe</u> that you have sent me."

As Christians, WE BELIEVE that we are...

3. HIS <u>CHURCH</u>

<u>Eph 5:25-27</u>

25 Husbands, love your wives, just <u>as Christ loved the church</u> and gave himself up for her 26 <u>to make her holy</u>, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, 27 and to present her to himself as a <u>radiant church</u>, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but <u>holy and blameless</u>.

4. <u>SAINTS</u>

<u>Rom 1:7</u>

To all in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints ...

<u>Phil 1:1</u>

Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, <u>To all the saints in</u> <u>Christ Jesus at Philippi...</u>

Rom 8:27

... <u>the Spirit intercedes for the saints</u> in accordance with God's will.

As Christians, WE BELIEVE that we are...

5. CALLED INTO <u>COMMUNION</u> <u>Communion</u>: Latin communio (sharing in common)

<u>Common bond</u> uniting Christians together (Jesus, the Christ)
