Phil 2:1-11, 12a, 14-15

1 If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, 2 then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose. 3 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. 4 Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. 5 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: 6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, 7 but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death- even death on a cross! 9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. 12 Therefore, my dear friends... 13... 14 Do everything without complaining or arguing, 15 so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe.

I. <u>BUILDING</u> OTHERS UP

Phil 2:3-4

Do nothing out of <u>selfish ambition</u> or vain conceit, but in humility <u>consider others better than yourselves</u>. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also <u>to the</u> <u>interests of others</u>.

We find joy by...

2. <u>SHINING</u>, NOT <u>WHINING</u>

<u>Phil 2:14-15</u>

14 <u>Do everything without complaining or arguing</u>, 15 so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you <u>shine like</u> <u>stars</u> in the universe.

Matt 5:14-16

14 "<u>You are the light of the world</u>. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and <u>it gives light to</u> <u>everyone</u> in the house. 16 In the same way, <u>let your light shine</u> <u>before men</u>, <u>that they may see your good deeds and praise your</u> <u>Father in heaven</u>.

We find joy through...

3. <u>SACRIFICIAL</u> LIVING

Phil 2:5, 7-8

5 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus:

7 [he] <u>made himself nothing</u>...

8 ... <u>he humbled himself</u> and became <u>obedient to death</u>- even death on a cross!

<u>Heb 12:1-2</u>

1... let us <u>throw off everything that hinders</u> and the <u>sin that so</u> <u>easily entangles</u>, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. 2 Let us <u>fix our eyes on Jesus</u>, the author and perfecter of our faith, who <u>for the joy set before him</u> endured the cross...
