Isa 53:4-7, 9-10,12 (written over 700 years before the birth of Christ)
4 Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we
considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. 5 But he
was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the
punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we
are healed. 6 We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to
his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all. 7 He was
oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a
lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did
not open his mouth. 8... 9 He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and
with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any
deceit in his mouth. 10 Yet it was the Lord's will to crush him and cause

1. SUFFER FOR OUR SAKE

2. REMAIN <u>SILENT</u> IN THE MIDST OF HIS SUFFERING

Isa 53:7

He was oppressed and afflicted, yet <u>he did not open his mouth</u>; he was <u>led like a lamb to the slaughter</u>, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so <u>he did not open his mouth</u>.

Matt 26:62-63

62 Then the high priest stood up and said to Jesus, "Are you not going to answer? What is this testimony that these men are bringing against you?" 63 But Jesus remained silent.

Matt 27:12-14

12 When he was accused by the chief priests and the elders, <u>he gave no answer</u>. 13 Then Pilate asked him, "Don't you hear the testimony they are bringing against you?" 14 But <u>Jesus made no reply</u>, not even to a single charge — to the great amazement of the governor.

4. SUFFER BECAUSE IT WAS GOD'S WILL

Isa 53:10

Yet it was the Lord's will to crush him and cause him to suffer...

Matt 26:39

Going a little farther, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will."

<u>Isa 53:6</u>

Rom 3:23-25
