Jesus was proclaimed The Holy One of God in scripture by...

1. THE ANGELS

Luke 1:35

The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the <u>holy one to be</u> born will be called the Son of God.

Luke 2:11

Today in the town of David <u>a Savior has been born</u> to you; <u>he is Christ the Lord</u>.

2. JOHN THE BAPTIST

John 1:20, 23, 32-34

20 [John] ... confessed freely, "I am not the Christ." 23 ... John replied in the words of Isaiah the prophet, "I am the voice of one calling in the desert, 'Make straight the way for the Lord." (Isa 40:3) 32 Then John gave this testimony: "I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him. 33 I would not have known him, except that the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is he who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.' 34 I have seen and I testify that this is the Son of God."

3. THE APOSTLE ANDREW

John 1:29, 41-42

29 ... John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, <u>the Lamb of God</u>, <u>who takes away the sin of the world!</u> 41 The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the <u>Messiah</u>" (that is, <u>the Christ</u>). 42 And he brought him to Jesus.

4. THE APOSTLE PETER

Matt 16:16

Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

John 6:69

We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God."

Acts 2:36

"Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: <u>God has made this Jesus</u>, whom you crucified, <u>both Lord and Christ</u>."

5. LAZARUS' SISTER MARTHA

John 11:25-27

25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; 26 and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" 27 "Yes, Lord," she told him, "I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who was to come into the world."

6. THE APOSTLE PAUL

Acts 17:2-3

2 As his custom was, Paul went into the synagogue, and on three Sabbath days he <u>reasoned with them from the Scriptures</u>, 3 ... "<u>This Jesus I am proclaiming to you is the Christ</u>," he said.

Acts 18:28

For [Paul] vigorously refuted the Jews in public debate, <u>proving from</u> the Scriptures that Jesus was the Christ.

7. JESUS HIMSELF

Luke 4:17-19, 21

[Jesus began to read] 18 "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, 19 to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." 21 and he [said] to them, "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

John 4:25-26

25 The woman said, "I know that Messiah" (called Christ) "is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us." 26 Then Jesus declared, "I who speak to you am he."

Mark 14:61-62

61 ... Again the high priest asked him, "Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?" 62 "I am," said Jesus.

Luke 23:3

So Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the king of the Jews?" "Yes, it is as you say," Jesus replied.
