2 Cor 12:2-10

2 I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know — God knows. 3 And I know that this man — whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, but God knows— 4 was caught up to paradise. He heard inexpressible things, things that man is not permitted to tell. 5 I will boast about a man like that, but I will not boast about myself, except about my weaknesses. 6 Even if I should choose to boast, I would not be a fool, because I would be speaking the truth. But I refrain, so no one will think more of me than is warranted by what I do or say. 7 To keep me from becoming conceited because of these surpassingly great revelations, there was given me a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. 8 Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. 9 But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. 10 That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

- 2 Cor 12:8, 5
- 8 Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me.
- 5 ... I will not boast about myself, except about my weaknesses.

2. THORNS KEEP US <u>HUMBLE</u> AND PRODUCE GROWTH

2 Cor 12:7, 10

7 To keep me from becoming conceited because of these surpassingly great revelations, there was given me a thorn in my flesh... 10 That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties...

James 1:2-4

2 <u>Consider it pure joy</u>, my brothers, <u>whenever you face trials</u> of many kinds, 3 because you know that <u>the testing of your faith</u> <u>develops perseverance</u>. 4 Perseverance must finish its work <u>so</u> <u>that you may be mature and complete</u>, not lacking anything.

2 Cor 12:9-10
