<u>1 Peter 5:5</u>

... All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "<u>God opposes the proud</u> but gives <u>grace to the humble</u>."

2. JESUS <u>EMBODIES</u> HUMILTY

<u>Phil 2:6-8</u>

6 [Jesus], being in very nature God, did not consider <u>equality</u> <u>with God</u> something to be grasped,

7 but <u>made himself nothing</u>, <u>taking the very nature of a servant</u>, being made in human likeness.

8 And being found in appearance as a man, <u>he humbled himself</u> and <u>became obedient to death</u> — even death on a cross!

3. WE ARE CALLED TO FOLLOW CHRISTS <u>EXAMPLE</u>

<u>Phil 2:5,3, 2</u>

- 5 Your attitude should be the <u>same as that of Christ Jesus</u>:
- 3 <u>Do nothing</u> out of <u>selfish ambition</u> or <u>vain conceit</u>, but <u>in humility consider others better</u> than yourselves.
- 2 ... being like-minded [with Christ], having the <u>same love</u>, being <u>one in spirit and purpose</u>.

4. HUMILITY RESULTS IN EXALTATION Phil 2:9-11

9 <u>THEREFORE</u> <u>God exalted him</u> to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Luke 18:14

[Jesus said] "I tell you that this man, rather than the other, <u>went</u> <u>home justified before God</u>. For <u>everyone who exalts himself will</u> <u>be humbled</u>, and <u>he who humbles himself will be exalted</u>."
