#### <u>Hebrews 5:11-6:1</u>

### 1. WE ARE VULNERABLE TO SPIRITUAL <u>COMPLACENCY</u>

#### <u>Heb 5:11-12</u>

11 We have much to say about this, but <u>it is hard to explain</u> because <u>you are slow to learn</u>. 12 In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. <u>You need milk</u>, <u>not solid food</u>!

#### <u>1 Cor 3:1-2</u>

1 Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but as worldly — <u>mere infants in Christ</u>. 2 <u>I gave you milk</u>, <u>not solid food</u>, for <u>you</u> <u>were not yet ready for it</u>. Indeed, you are still not ready.

## 2. THE GOAL IS <u>RIGHTEOUS</u> LIVING

#### <u>Heb 5:13</u>

Anyone who lives on milk, being <u>still an infant</u>, is <u>not</u> acquainted with the teaching about righteousness.

#### <u>Eph 4:13-15</u>

13 ... <u>become mature</u>, attaining to the <u>whole measure of the</u> <u>fullness of Christ</u>. 14 Then we will <u>no longer be infants</u>, <u>tossed</u> <u>back and forth by the waves</u>, and <u>blown here and there by every</u> <u>wind</u> of teaching ... 15 Instead, ... <u>in all things grow up into him</u> who is the Head, that is, Christ.

#### <u>1 Peter 1:16</u>

... it is written: "<u>Be holy</u>, because <u>I am holy</u>."

## 3. CHRISTLIKENESS IS INTENTIONALLY <u>PURSUED</u>

#### <u>Heb 5:14-6:1</u>

5:14 But <u>solid food is for the mature</u>, who <u>by constant use</u> have <u>trained themselves</u> to distinguish good from evil. 6:1 Therefore <u>let us leave the elementary teachings about Christ and go on to</u> <u>maturity</u>...

#### <u>2 Tim 2:22</u>

Flee the evil desires of youth, and <u>pursue righteousness</u>, faith, love and peace...

#### <u>Phil 3:16</u>

... let us live up to what we have already attained.

#### <u>Rom 2:4</u>

... God's kindness leads you toward repentance...

#### <u>Matt 6:33</u>

... seek first his kingdom and his righteousness...

#### <u>Matt 5:6</u>

Blessed are those who <u>hunger and thirst for righteousness</u>, for they will be filled.
