#### 2 Timothy 3:16-17, 4:1-5

16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, 17 so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. 4:1 In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom, I give you this charge: 2 Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage — with great patience and careful instruction. 3 For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. 4 They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. 5 But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.

False doctrines emerge when...

## I. HUMAN IDEAS ARE <u>ADDED</u> TO SCRIPTURE

<u>2 Peter 2:1-3</u>

I ... <u>there will be false teachers among you</u>. They will <u>secretly</u> <u>introduce destructive heresies</u>, <u>even denying the sovereign Lord</u> <u>who bought them</u>-bringing swift destruction on themselves. 2 Many will follow their shameful ways and will bring the way of truth into disrepute. 3 In their greed <u>these teachers will exploit</u> <u>you with stories they have made up</u>. Their condemnation has long been hanging over them, and their destruction has not been sleeping. False doctrines emerge when...

# 2. SCRIPTURE IS INTERPRETED <u>ERRONEOUSLY</u>

That's why it's best to:

- Read (and study) Scripture for <u>yourself</u>
- Engage the <u>Holy Spirit</u> as you read and interpret Scripture
- Assess for <u>harmony</u> with other Scripture

## 3. SCRIPTURE IS <u>SOFTENED</u> BY DISTORTING THE MEANING IN AN EFFORT NOT TO <u>OFFEND</u>
