<u>Eph 2:12-18</u>

12 remember that at that time (when we were sinners) you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. 13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ. 14 For <u>he himself is our peace</u>, who has made the two one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, 15 by <u>abolishing</u> in his flesh the law with its commandments and regulations. His purpose was to create in himself <u>one new man out of the two</u>, thus making peace, 16 and in this one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility. 17 <u>He came and preached peace</u> to you who were far away and <u>peace</u> to those who were near. 18 For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

I. IS AVAILABLE THROUGH JESUS
