#### <u>Isa 40:11</u>

[The Sovereign Lord] <u>tends his flock</u> like a shepherd: He <u>gathers the</u> <u>lambs in his arms</u> and <u>carries them close to his heart</u>; he <u>gently leads</u> [them]...

### Isaiah 53:5-7

6 We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all. 7 He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth. 5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.
