Psalm 23:1-6

1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. 3 <u>He restores my soul; He leads me in the</u> <u>paths of righteousness for His name's sake</u>. 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever. (NKJV)

What can we learn from our Good Shepherd (Jesus)?

Jesus wants to...

1. <u>LIFT</u> YOU TO YOUR FEET

<u>Psa 23:3a</u> "<u>He restores my soul</u>;"

Luke 15 (Parable of the lost sheep)

John 10:14-15

14 "I am the good shepherd... 15 ... <u>I lay down my life for</u> <u>the sheep</u>.

<u>1 John 3:16</u>

This is how we know what love is: <u>Jesus Christ laid down</u> <u>his life for us</u>... Jesus wants to...

2. LEAD YOU INTO HOLY LIVING

Psa 23:3b "He leads me in the paths of righteousness..."

<u>Isa 53:6</u>

We all, like sheep, <u>have gone astray</u>, each of us has turned to his own way;

Prov 14:12

There is <u>a way that seems right to a man</u>, but in the end it leads to death.

Jesus wants to...

3. <u>GLORIFY</u> HIMSELF THROUGH YOU

<u>Psa 23:3c</u> "He leads me in the paths of righteousness <u>for</u> <u>His name's sake</u>."

"for His name's sake" means to bring God glory.
