Amazing Grace: Pursuing Grace

Luke 15:1-7

I Now the tax collectors and "sinners" were all gathering around to hear him. 2 But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." 3 Then Jesus told them this parable: 4 "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Does he not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? 5 And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders 6 and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' 7 I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent."

Scripture tells us that...

1. WE ARE ALL LOST

Rom 3:23-24

23 for <u>all have sinned</u> and <u>fall short of the glory of God</u>, 24 and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

Rom 5:6, 8

6 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. 7 ... 8 ... God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Scripture tells us that...

2. JESUS PASSIONATELY <u>PURSUES</u> THE LOST Luke 19:10

"... the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost."

<u>1 Tim 2:4</u>

[God] wants <u>all men to be saved</u> and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

John 12:32

[Jesus said] 32 "... when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself."

1 John 4:10

To This is love: not that we loved God, but that <u>he loved us</u> and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

Scripture tells us that...

3. JESUS <u>REJOICES</u> WHEN THE LOST ARE FOUND

Luke 15:5-6

5 And when he finds [his lost sheep] ... 6 ... he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.'

John 15:16

[Jesus said] "You did not choose me, but I chose you..."

1 Peter 2:9
